- ④ Experience or background in natural product chemistry.
- ⑤ Experience or background in synthetic organic chemistry.
- ⑥ Experience in chemical structure determination of natural products.

Preferred (not required)

- ⑦ Familiarity with bioinformatics.
- ⑧ Experience in compound screening and activity evaluation.
- ⑨ Experience working with mice and other laboratory animals.
